Join us to hear what CTWC has been doing. We will present an update of our continuing efforts and the latest information on water issues.

LCRA is working on changes to their Water Rates and the Board is considering new rates for both firm and interruptible customers. We have asked a representative from LCRA to attend this meeting to answer any questions you may have.

Also, LCRA is seeking emergency relief in their application to TCEQ for a 2014 Emergency Order which is more protective than the 2012 and 2013 Emergency Orders. We will talk about what this means and what you should do.

The drought has been unprecedented with no relief in site and because of lack of significant rain and very low inflows the Lakes have not recovered even without the normal releases downstream in 2012 and 2013. Updated scientific data must be used to protect drinking water supplies when planning for the future!
