For the past two years, the City of Austin has been engaged with writing a new comprehensive plan, known as Imagine Austin, that will guide the city's development and growth for the next few decades. This long-awaited plan emerges from a complicated history of planning in Austin, and is finally coming to fruition in large part due to the work of the Citizens Advisory Task Force, an appointed group of passionate and diverse Austinites that has facilitated community input throughout the planning process.

Panel members will share their accounts of the long road to developing Imagine Austin, the final steps to implementation, and their visions about what the future holds for environment, development, and social equity in Austin.
