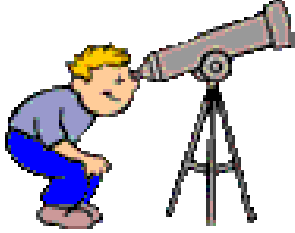


Stars-in-the-Park

Come join us for an educational and fun-filled evening in the park learning about ASTRONOMY and watching the STARS and PLANETS through a variety of TELESCOPES. Meet at the Park Pavilion at 6:00 pm.

Volunteer astronomers will be on hand to help with the telescopes and explain the wonders of Blanco's nighttime sky. If you need red cellophane for your flashlights (to preserve night vision), Friends of the Park volunteers will be there to help you. You can also join (for Free!) the Hill Country Alliance's Night Sky Co-op to fight light pollution and help preserve the Hill Country's starry skies.

The event is free with a day entry permit into Blanco State Park - \$4.00 for those 13 and older, free for those 12 and younger and for Texas State Park Pass holders.
